



In-Person Ministry Meeting Guidelines

To ensure the safety and health of our parishioners and community, St. Philip Neri has put together the following regulations for ministries. Ministries may continue to meet online or virtually. For all ministries with in-person meetings, guidelines will be put into place.

For any family expecting to attend ministry meetings, parish events, faith formation, etc. a COVID-19 Assumption of Risk waiver must be filled out. Only one waiver needs to be filled out per family and only needs to be filled out once, as it will apply for all ministries and events. St. Philip Neri will retain each family's waiver and keep it on file.

For all ministries desiring in-person meetings, the following guidelines will be expected:

- COVID-19 Assumption of Risk waivers must be signed. Once filled out, the parish will keep the forms on file. Forms only need to be signed once.
- All participants (ages 6+) must wear a face mask. Children under the age of 6 are encouraged to wear face masks but are not required.
- Shared doors should remain open to decrease contact.
- Social distancing should be enforced whenever possible.
- Leaders should keep an attendance log.
- If food is provided, extra precautions should be taken and pre-packaged food is encouraged.
- All participants are encouraged to take their temperature before attending a meeting and are expected to stay home if sick or temperature exceeds 100.4 degrees.

For all Education Ministries for youth at St. Philip Neri (the Child Development Center, Faith Formation, Edge, Confirmation, and Life Teen), the above guidelines will be adopted, in addition to the following:

- Children and teens will have their temperatures checked upon arrival.
- A Health Assessment question checklist will be conducted.
- A sick policy will be put into place and will be given to the parents.

We thank all parishioners for cooperation in creating an environment which allows for encountering Christ but also allows for the safety and health of all.
